
♠ bout a year before retiring, I was pushing our leadership team to purchase a boutique hotel named El Castillo in Ojochal, Costa Rica to use as an employee retreat. They decided against the idea, so when I saw the property was still for sale after I retired, I decided to purchase it myself. My wife and I love to travel, so it was a natural fit. I was 55 years old, still had a lot of energy, and wanted to stay busy, so the adventure of owning a small hotel in Costa Rica was appealing. Then, I was having so much fun that I decided to build a new resort, and I wanted it to be unique to the world.

Central America was the logical choice because it is easy to reach from our U.S. home, and the time zone is virtually the same. I spent a year looking online for the perfect location. Although I love Costa Rica, I wanted to try something new. Panama has several appealing advantages: it's hurricane-free, has a stable government, uses the US dollar as its currency, and the country has a new emphasis on tourism. The Caribbean vibe of the Bocas Del Toro Archipelago with its white sand beaches, charming Bocas Town, and the ability to build over the water sealed the deal. Owning an island resort needs to be a passion project and the leadership team running the resort is what will

make or break you. Just remember that the cost of building on a private island will be much higher than you expect (add at least 30 percent to your estimates).

Before building the resort, I knew little about sustainability. As I learned more about what was needed to keep the crystal-clear water around our island healthy and to preserve the island itself, I became a huge advocate. Today we are a model in sustainability with solar power, purified rainwater for drinking, advanced wastewater treatment, composting, and ecofriendly pest control. But the area I am most proud of is our coral restoration. As a result of these initiatives, the water around our island continues to be crystal clear and the island has more dart frogs, birds, and butterflies than ever. I travel to the resort about three times each year and enjoy spending time with our staff and talking with our guests. It's a magical place.

he Pearl Islands, tucked safely below the hurricane belt in the Gulf of Panama, represent one of the last untouched island regions close to North America. This collection of more than 200 mostly uninhabited islands and islets is renowned for its dazzling waters and postcard-worthy beaches as well as world-class fishing and scuba diving. Within this archipelago is a rare commodity, a 200plus acre island with a title free of the government ties or ownership issues that hinder sales of nearly all other Pearl Islands.

Stunning Isla Gitana, its sprawling acreage an emerald blanket of tropical vegetation, is home to one of the richest marine and bird sanctuaries on the planet. Whales frolic off its shores during the July to October mating season and white-sand beaches dot its coastline, totaling more than a mile of sun-kissed sanctuary. Isla Gitana's main beaches face the open water, away from the eyes of passing boaters, while its shape and position provide protected anchorage and its bay delivers a sheltered spot for a marina.

Development possibilities are endless for a property that is not only grand and naturally beautiful, but also benefits from Panama's use of U.S. currency, government stability, and support for tourism. All necessary infrastructure for creating and staffing a resort are readily available, and because so many of the Pearl Islands are government-owned, there is a built-in privacy buffer for the foreseeable future. Ritz-Carlton currently has a large-scale project under way in the area, further underscoring Isla Gitana's potential. The island also has an added pedigree, with Private Islands Inc. founder Chris Krolow offering a roadmap to develop Isla Gitana as the large-scale counterpart to his Gladden Private Island success in Belize. Instead of one villa on one island with staff housed on the island next door, Isla Gitana has the space for numerous luxury villas set into secluded multi-acre parcels-all offering an experience that celebrates solitude while delivering the amenities of a fully staffed resort.

n the Bocas Del Toro Archipelago of northeast Panama, the warm, crystalline Caribbean Sea teems with so much diverse marine life that the Smithsonian Tropical Research Institute has settled there. Amid this vibrant landscape, the new Nayara Bocas Del Toro offers an idyllic one-of-a-kind base for sustainable immersion in the magic of the region. The romantic adults-only private island resort, nestled beside the mangroves and forest of Frangipani Island, immediately earned accolades upon opening for its elegant overwater villas, lush natural setting, off-grid construction, and coral reef restoration efforts.

Each of the 16 Balinese-style villas, decked out with carved teak furnishings, feature private pools and oceanfront swim-up terraces, with some adding a glass floor inlay to observe the fish darting below. Four treehouse villas made from bamboo and reclaimed hardwoods soar 50 feet above the ground for a bird's eye view of the forest and sea from sunrise to sunset. The all-inclusive accommodations are complemented by a spa, 70-foot freshwater pool, and the world's only aerial beach, a spacious stretch of sand constructed on stilts. Named after the Indonesian word for butterfly, Kupa-Kupa beach has a tiled staircase spilling into the crystal-clear sea, creating the illusion of entering a pool.

The resort's Elephant House restaurant, a 100-year old structure that traveled all the way from Bali, earns raves for its constantly changing menu sourced from local ingredients. In the evenings, underwater lighting showcases a kaleidoscopic display of fish—along with the occasional stingray or shark—as accompaniment to the international cuisine. A maze of raised boardwalks weave through the island's 80 acres of mangroves, home to dart frogs and tropical birds. With six boats and full-time captains who are trained naturalists, the wonders of Bocas Del Toro are always within reach—from islands populated with monkeys and sloths to snorkeling in the "Galapagos of the Caribbean."

Stunningly beautiful, steeped in history, and surrounded by the most extraordinary land and seascapes, Argyll Island embodies everything that the ultimate Scottish island should be. Argyll Island's current owners purchased it more than a quarter century ago and spent several million impeccably upgrading it to modern standards, including undersea and underground three-phase electrical mains with fully automatic three-phase generator backup, a new deep fresh water supply via a 95-meter well, and a dedicated insulated and dehumidified 500-square-meter hangar for up to two light-to-medium helicopters, a microwave telecommunications link to the mainland, and high-speed internet via Starlink. After using the island as a holiday home, the couple moved here permanently seven years ago and have upgraded the island's infrastructure even further, with some £1 million in additional improvements, like a new ultra-modern floating jetty for better, deeper yacht mooring with electrics, and an extensive network of paths and bridges so that the entire magnificent island can be enjoyed throughout the year. It also has a five-year average of five deer annually for hunting, if so desired.



With cerulean water that beckons fishing enthusiasts, yachters, and scuba divers from the around the world, The Bahamas continue to soar in popularity—and the Abacos boast the most sought-after private island real estate in this Caribbean playground. Baker's Bay Beach & Golf Club, a members-only beach community in Great Guana Cay, serves as a celebrity magnet for A-listers like Michael Jordan, Tom Brady, and Jennifer Lopez. A short boat ride away from this exclusive enclave is Tilloo Pond, an 11-acre estate set on five-mile long Tilloo Cay and ensconced in the Tilloo Cay National Reserve. No public access is allowed, ensuring utmost privacy.

The completely renovated estate touches both the Sea of Abaco and the Atlantic Ocean for sea to sea views and features three luxury villas that can sleep up to 12 people. Covered walkways and wraparound verandahs connect the accommodations: the Main Villa with king bedroom, 1.5 baths, doublesided fireplace, gourmet kitchen, living room, and integrated music system, serving as a gathering point; the secluded Master Villa with bedroom suite, library, and kitchenette; and the Guest Villa with three suites spread over two floors. The property also has a pool, sunset-viewing patio, and caretaker housing. Set between Spanish Cay and Manjack Cay in the Sea of Abaco, Powell Cay is just three miles northeast of the village of Coopers Town, one of the northernmost settlements on Great Abaco.

With a total footprint of approximately 294 acres, Powell Cay's southern 168 acres are owned by the Crown and are set aside for a proposed nature reserve. This makes the island's other 126 acres on its north end the ideal location for a boutique resort or peaceful private retreat. Just one island to the north is Spanish Cay with its beautiful and popular resort and marina, while directly across the Sea of Abaco on Great Abaco is Coopers Town, a quaint hamlet with just under 700 permanent residents and a small selection of restaurants, medical services, and other facilities. Just half an hour's drive southeast of Coopers Town is the slightly bigger Treasure Cay, while just 45 minutes away is Marsh Harbour, the largest town in The Abacos with nearly 6,300 permanent residents. Not only does Marsh Harbour have a variety of shops, travel agencies, adventure companies, and a post office, it's also home to Leonard M. Thompson International Airport, the main air hub for The Abacos, offering regular direct flights to several cities on the US mainland and across The Bahamas.

The deep-ocean canyon bordering the archipelago, known as the Tongue of the Ocean, draws all manner of marine life to this unique area. Now you can own two gorgeous private islands in the Berry chain, spanning over 83 acres in all and offering myriad opportunities for swimming, water skiing, windsurfing and fishing right at your doorstep.

Boasting clear turquoise Caribbean waters, powdery white sand beaches, secluded coves, untouched reefs, and lush vegetation teeming with native birdlife, Frozen Cay and Alder Cay are pristine havens just awaiting your discovery. Accessible by private boat or seaplane, these two islands are only a short 35-mile journey from Nassau. 

n the Parry Sound District of Georgian Bay, the most common sounds are bird calls and breeze rustling the evergreens. A fire tower and a utility cabin complete the expansive property.

Monthly rental of Burritts Island starts at CAD 50,000 and includes island hopping excursions, fishing trips, and boat service for the 30-minute journey to and from the marina in Britt, seven miles away.
