





short helicopter flight from Rio de Janeiro lies A region of Brazil where the pace slows to align with the gently undulating sea that brushes against its abundant white sands. This is Angra dos Reis, a Brazilian municipality that incorporates 365 islands and more than 2,000 beaches, creating a haven for affluent travelers seeking respite from the urban jungle. Within this aptly named "Green Coast" is a signature property from the Private Islands portfolio unlike anything accessible on the mainland. Over the past two decades, Ilha Mirante has been carefully developed to operate as an allinclusive island escape for one group of 2-4 guests. This magnificent retreat spans a 6.1-acre tropical playground with its own private beach fringed in bromeliads, swimming pool, hot tub and contemporary villa.

Upon arrival at Ilha Mirante, you'll find 7,000-square-feet of living space awash in light. The villa, with Its master suite and king suite, each with full bath, is a marvel of gleaming Brazilian and Balinese hardwoods from floor to ceiling, with stone accent walls and furnishings. 

The word Rangiroa means "vast sky" in Tuamotuan, but it's the sea here, in one of the world's largest atolls, that steals the show. The water glows a luminous turquoise, showcasing a marriage of the clearest water and the whitest sands. This remote star of French Polynesia also houses one of the richest coral reefs in the world, earning it global acclaim for scuba diving and snorkeling. In this heavenly habitat, Private Islands Inc. has selected a standout island for its portfolio that has the potential to become one of the most desirable incomegenerating properties in the South Pacific.
